YODO KURAHASHI II is one of Japan's great Master Shakuhachi flute players. He has been with this beautiful and evocative bamboo instrument for more than 40 years. His father, also a famous shakuhachi player, was his first teacher as a young boy. His recordings have won awards and he has appeared often on television in Japan. Yodo Kurahashi travels internationally, teaching and promoting shakuhachi.



JOHN SINGER, master shakuhachi teacher, performer, recording artist and former shakuhachi instructor at the University of Hawaii, has performed music on the Japanese bamboo flute since 1975. After several years of intensive study in Japan under the tutelage of the late Shakuhachi Master Matsumura Homei, and the late Grand Master and Living National Treasure Yamaguchi Goro, John Singer was awarded a Shihan (Master Teacher certificate) in 1982.
